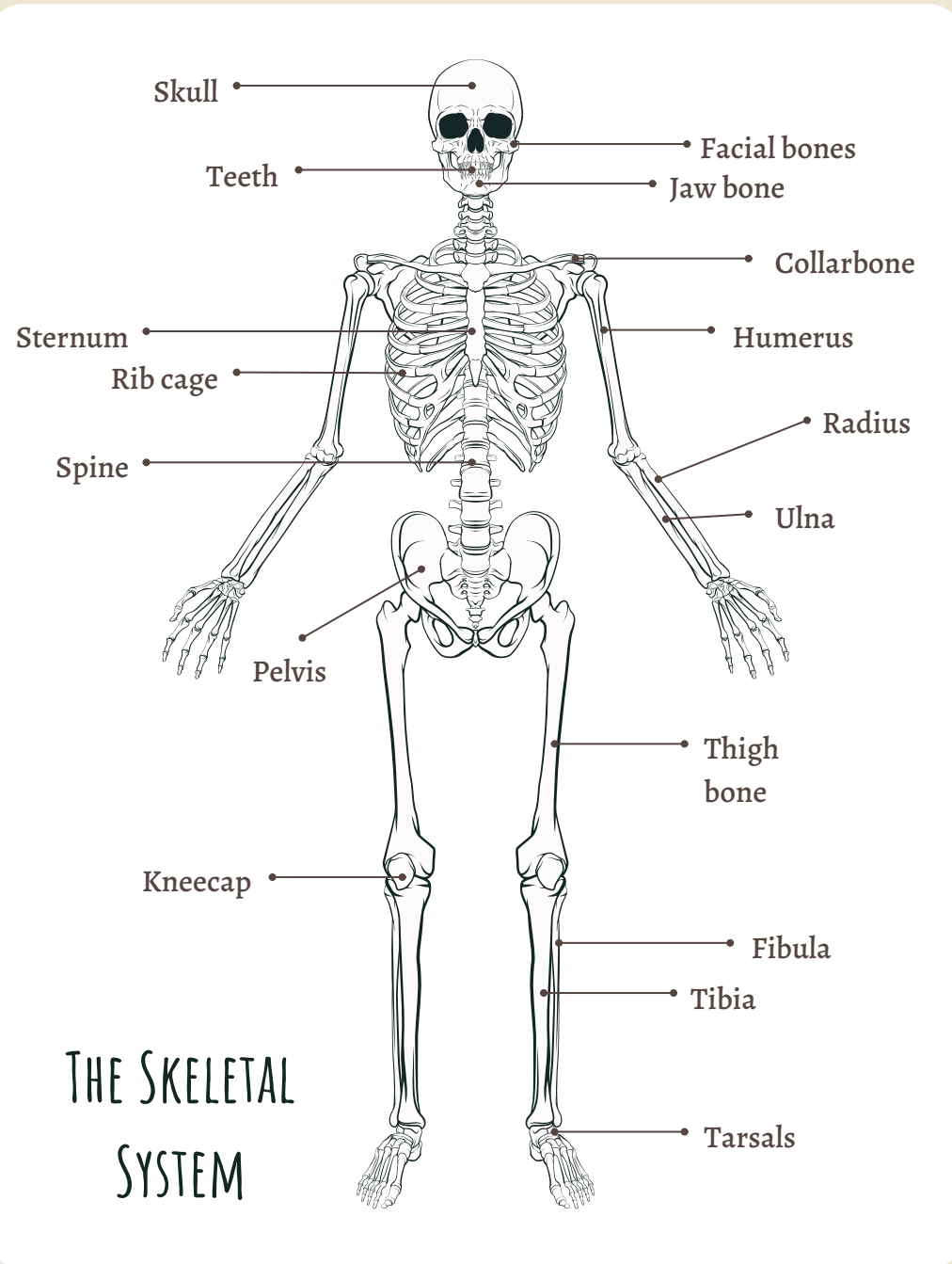

③ movement

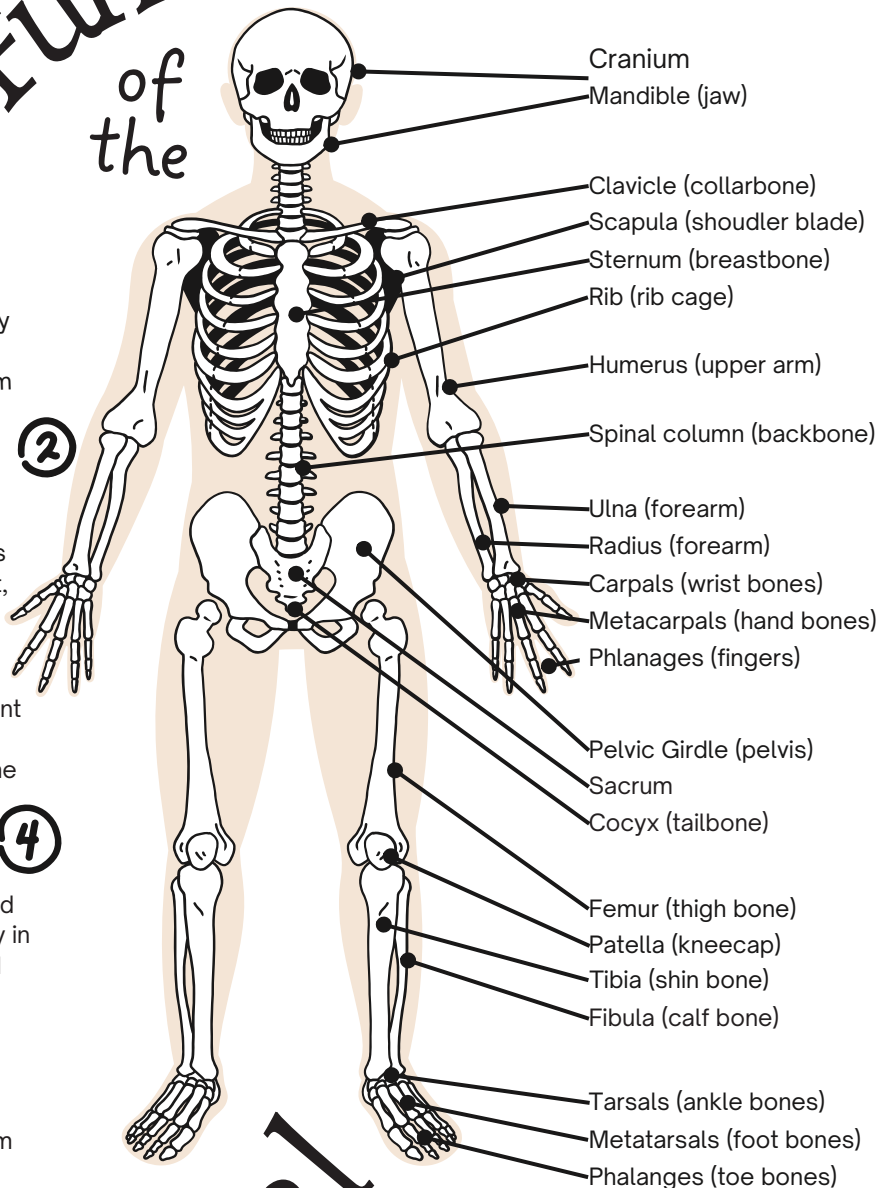
Allows movement by working together with the muscles

④ factory

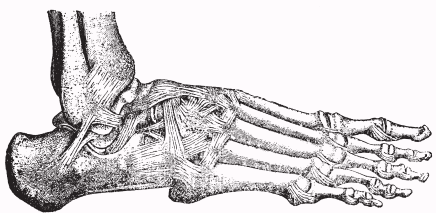
Forms red blood cells, specifically in the bone's red marrow

⑤ storage

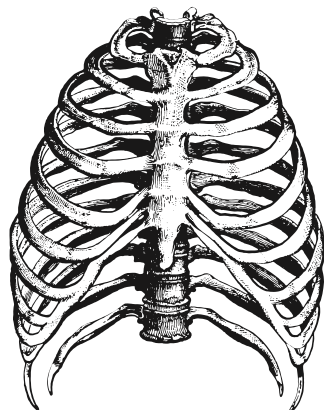
Stores and releases calcium to the body



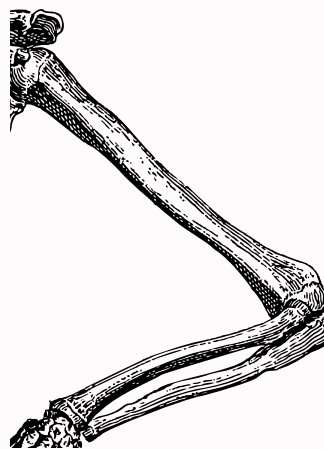
